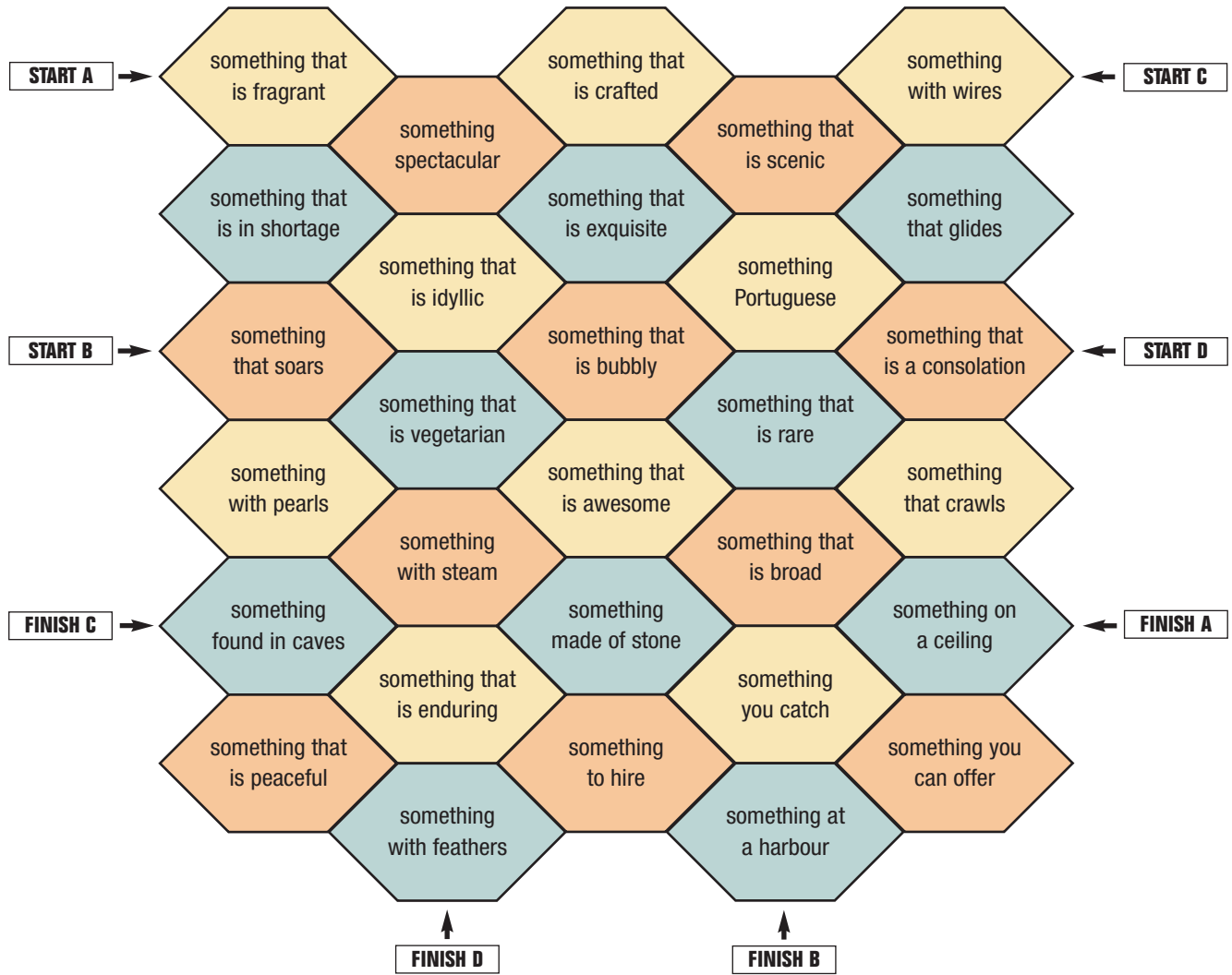


The Garden Route Vocabulary Game

Play this board game in small groups.



Rules

1. Play the game in groups of three or four. Each student gets a counter and places it on one of the letter circles (A, B, C, D) marked Start.
2. The aim of the game is to move across the board, one space at a time, in any direction, to reach the same letter circle marked Finish. So the player at A Start should end up at A Finish.
3. The first player chooses the hexagon nearest to his or her letter circle and names an object that matches the description. For example, player A chooses “something that is fragrant” and says “jasmine blossoms”. In order to advance to the next space, he/she must talk about the object (jasmine blossoms) for at least 15 seconds.
4. Players take turns to play. A player who cannot name an object misses a turn. Two players cannot be on the same space at the same time.
5. The winner is the first player to reach Finish for his or her letter.
