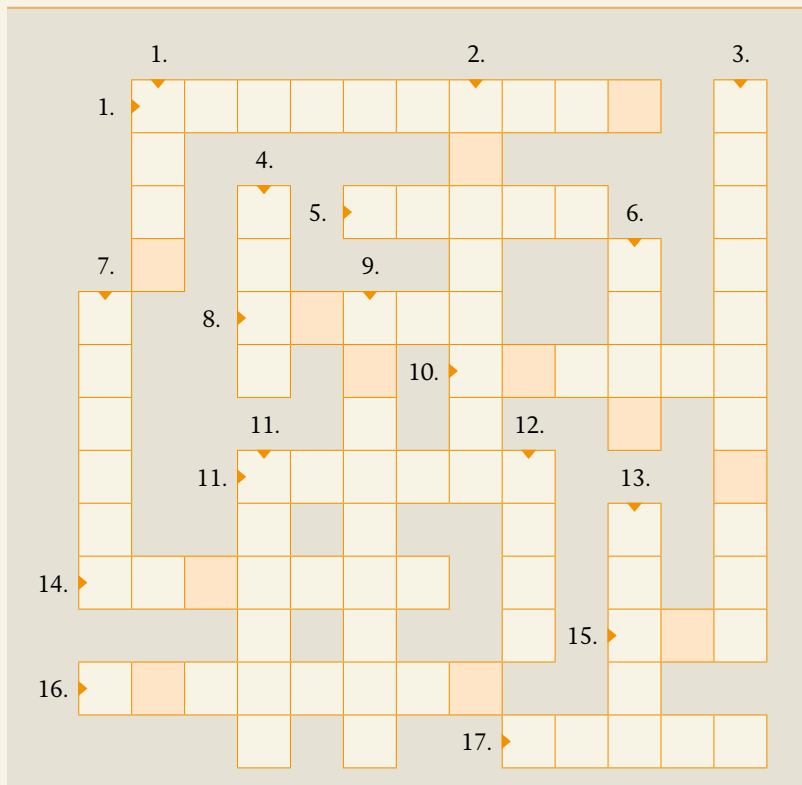

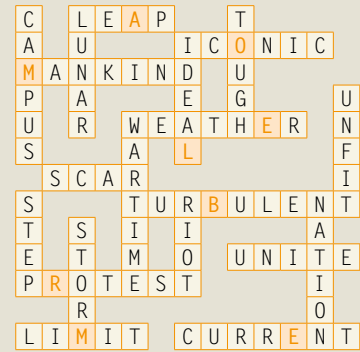


How to take part
